

STUDENT VISA BREACHES

Under the ESOS Act the School has various obligations to meet if an overseas student breaches their visa obligations. Refer to our **Unsatisfactory Course Progress or Attendance Policy** and **Overseas Students Complaints Handling Policy**.

Under section 20 of the ESOS Act, if a student breaches a condition of their visa, the School must send the student a written notice as soon as practicable after the breach. The notice must be sent even if the student has ceased to be an accepted student of the School and the notice must comply with the requirements of section 20 of the ESOS Act.

Under section 108 of the ESOS Act, it is a criminal offence, with a penalty of imprisonment for 12 months, if a person provides false or misleading information about accepted students under section 20.
